# Science

---

College-prep science includes:

- physical science, biology, chemistry, advanced biology, physics, natural resources, college biology, college chemistry

Additional science credits (not accepted as college prep):

- horticulture, environmental ag, greenhouse, animal science sports nutrition, food science

Chemistry pre-requisite is algebra II

College Biology pre-requisite is chemistry & Asset reading 41 or ACT reading 19

College Chemistry pre-requisite is chemistry



# Social Studies

---

## ○ Required:

- American Government – 5 credits

## ○ Additional Social Studies (World Geography 10, Global Studies 5, Personal Finance 5, American History 10 – will need 5 additional unless completed Leaders in American History)

- Sociology – 5 credits
- Psychology – 5 credits
- Economics – 5 credits
- Current Issues – 5 credits
- History of Film Studies – 5 credits
- Holocaust Studies – 5 credits

# Math

---

- Placement based on math sequence, test scores, math grades, & classroom performance
- College-Prep Math includes algebra I and above (pre-algebra, intermediate algebra, and standards math are not accepted by the University or the NCAA)
- Students need to enroll in a minimum of 10 math credits each year
- College Math options:
  - College Algebra – 3 college credits, ACT 22 Math req.
  - College Calculus – 5 college credits, ACT 25 Math req.

# English

---

## ⦿ College-Prep English credits:

- English IV
- Honors College Composition
  - 5 credits (3 college credits – NE Wesleyan University)
- Honors College Writing/Research
  - 5 credits (3 college credits – CCC)
- Honors College World Literature
  - 5 credits (3 college credits – NE Wesleyan University)

## ⦿ Note:

- Creative Writing & Journalism do NOT meet English requirements for graduation

# Foreign Language

---

- ◉ Two years required for admission to UNL, UNK, UNO
- ◉ Some majors at UNL require 4 years:
  - [admissions.unl.edu/become/requirements/foreign-language.aspx](http://admissions.unl.edu/become/requirements/foreign-language.aspx)
- ◉ Honors II required to enroll in III & IV
- ◉ Pre-requisites:
  - Spanish I – 80% in English
  - Spanish II – 80% in Spanish I
  - Honors Spanish II – 85% in Spanish I
  - Honors Spanish III & IV – 80% in prior honors class

# Test Score Requirements for College-Credit Classes

---

## ○ College Algebra

- ACT Math 22 OR
- Asset Test:
  - Numerical Skills – 42
  - Elementary Algebra – 43
  - Intermediate Algebra - 41

## ○ College Composition

- ACT English and Reading 19 OR
- Asset Test:
  - Writing – 42
  - Reading - 40

## ○ College Calculus

- ACT Math 25

# Additional Information

---

- Select credits to total 80
- Select alternate courses (rank by preference)
- Weighted courses:
  - + indicates 4.5 grading scale and are dual-credit courses
  - ^ indicates 4.25 grading scale and are available as honors classes
- Supervised Career Experience is available either semester – not to exceed 10 credits
- Senior Open is available 2<sup>nd</sup> semester only – equivalent of 5 cr.
- Work-Based Learning is available 4<sup>th</sup> block 1<sup>st</sup> and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> semester
- Online college-credit classes are available through Peru State and UNL – see your handbook for a listing of those courses
- Required courses must be repeated if a grade below 70% or 1.5 was received
- Check your “Grad Planner” for credit deficiencies in IC
- Get your signatures PRIOR to online registration next week
